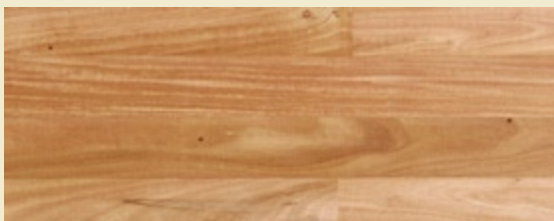

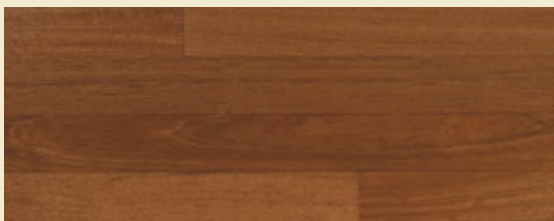
Amendoim

As unique as its name, this wood is a warm, medium tan/brown with reddish highlights, swirling grain and small burl figures.



Australian Cypress

This is a deceptively hard wood from “down under,” with the warm, rustic look of softer woods.



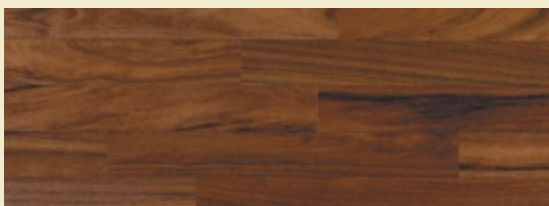
Brazilian Cherry

This is one of our most popular imported woods, renowned for its hardness and durability.



Brazilian Teak

An extremely hard, dense wood, this Central and South American native is brownish red with a unique coarse grain.



Caribbean Walnut

With its wide range of color, striping and swirling grains, this wood lets you make a dramatic design statement.



Patagonian Cherry

Imported from Paraguay, this is an extremely dense wood with a unique pinkish red/rose coloring.

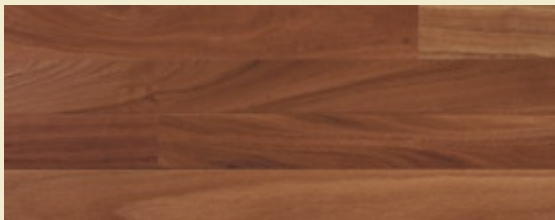


Patagonian Rosewood

Much harder than Red Oak, this wood is a reddish brown with intriguing black streaking. It will darken and redden over time.

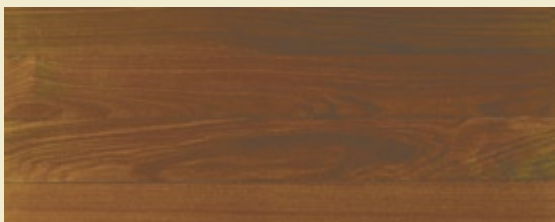

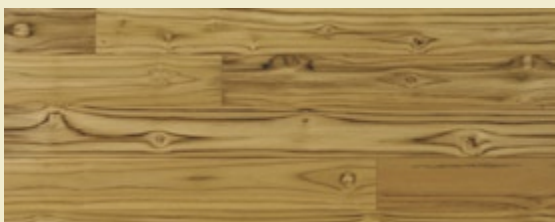
Red River Gum

Santos Mahogany

Extremely dense and stable, this Mahogany-looking wood is one of our most popular exotic choices.

This is one of the world’s most durable and stable woods, with coloring from pale yellows to orange browns with darker striping, all mellowing into medium browns.

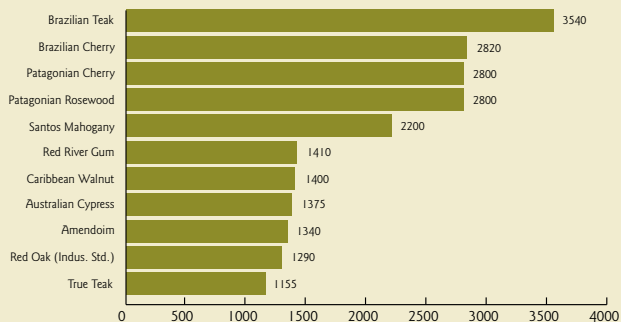

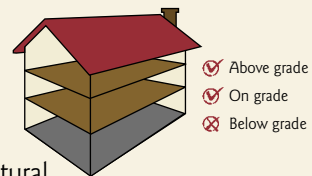


3/4" Plank

Because our Exotics are all natural solid wood, they are susceptible to the effects of moisture. They should be used at or above ground level and in rooms where dampness is not a concern. Solid 3/4" flooring can be nailed, 3/8" can be nailed or glued.

Our High Wear finish isn't quite bulletproof. But almost.

All of exotic woods shown are offered pre-finished. And with nine coats of finish, you can believe we cut no corners to protect these beauties. High Wear, UV-cured Acrylic Urethane. Aluminum Oxide in the base coats. Satin Anti-scratch top coats. So, thanks to our nine coat technology, your floor will have nine lives or more.

Easy clean. Easy care. Just that.

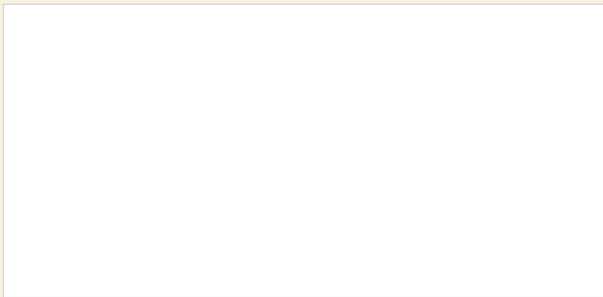
