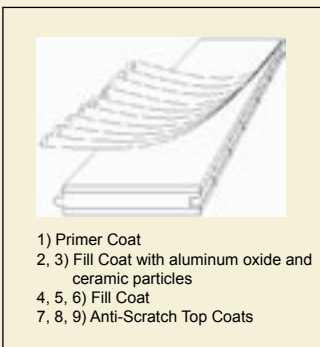

With precision milling, lengths to 4’ in the 3” width and an extra-long 87” length in the 5” width, WFI MultiPLY flooring is pre-finished with one of the hardest-wearing and smoothest finishes on the market today.



- The top wear layer is a one-piece, sliced veneer providing the look of true wood
- Constructed with seven cross-banded layers to provide enhanced stability
- Milled with Ultra Micro-Eased Edges and Square Ends
- Reasonably priced for the quality and look

High Wear Finish:

9-coat, High-Wear UV-cured, Acrylic Urethane with Aluminum Oxide in the base coats and Anti-Scratch top coats in a Satin Gloss.

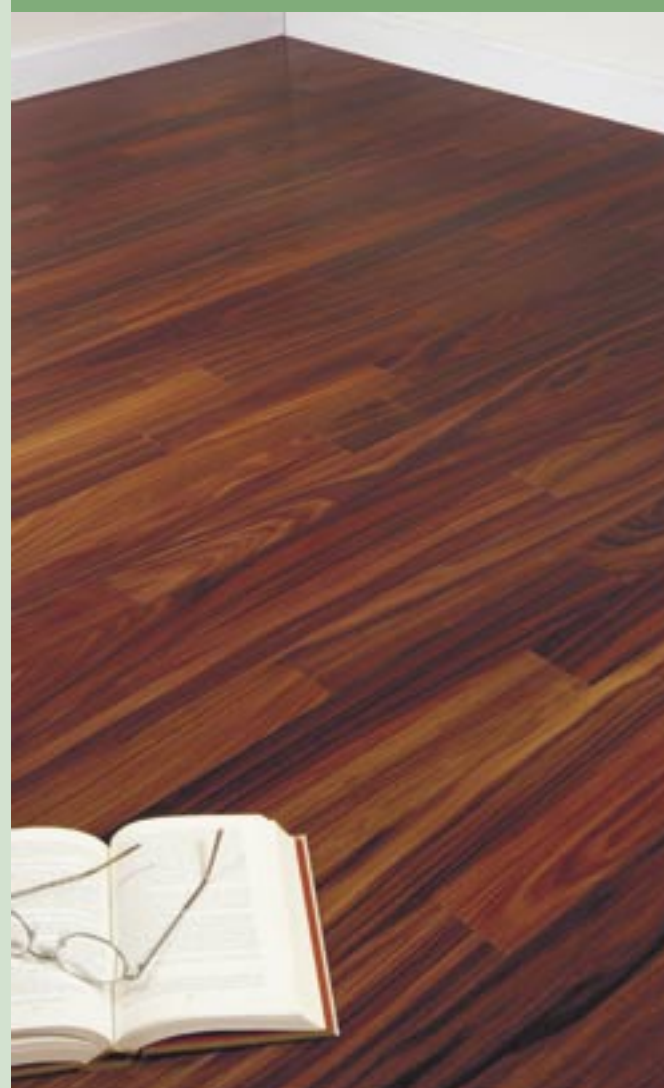

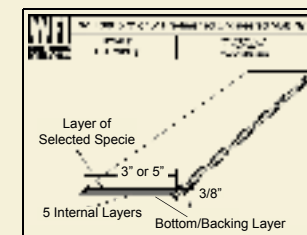

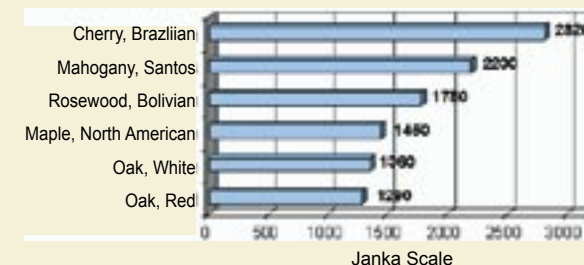


What is Engineered Wood Flooring?

Engineered wood flooring is designed to resist wood's natural tendency to change dimensionally over time. Comprised of multiple layers of wood, cross-banded for stability, this construction style is known as "engineered" wood flooring. Unlike solid wood flooring, engineered wood floors can be used in a greater range of installation settings and may be glued, stapled or floated on a wide variety of subfloors.

Exotic Species



▲ Bolivian Rosewood

Truly one of the world's most beautiful woods. Used in the finest hand-crafted furniture and musical instruments. Bolivian Rosewood will certainly make a design statement !



▲ Brazilian Cherry

The most popular imported flooring species. Known for its hardness and durability, it is available in selected straight grain (as shown) as well as mixed grain.



▲ Santos Mahogany

A darker Mahogany-looking type wood with extreme density and stability. One of the most popular exotic flooring choices.



▲ Timborana

A species widely used in flooring in Europe destined to become a North American favorite. A tannish-brown coloring with developing reddish tones and subtle graining, adding warmth to any setting.

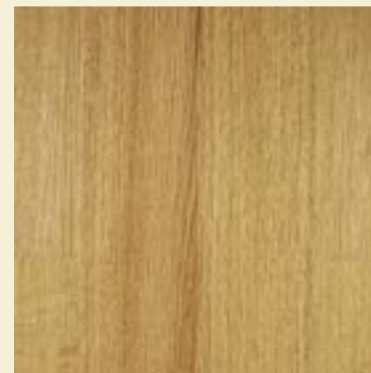
▲ North American Maple
