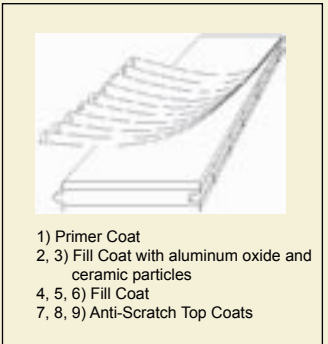

This collection offers four different woods, all of which have been slightly tinted to provide more color uniformity; Brazilian Cherry - Classic, in a natural, reddish tint, Brazilian Cherry - Auburn, in a darker brownish-red tint, the teak-like Timborana, and the unique Silky Ash. 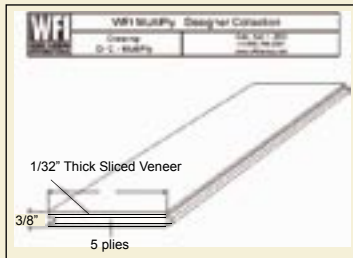

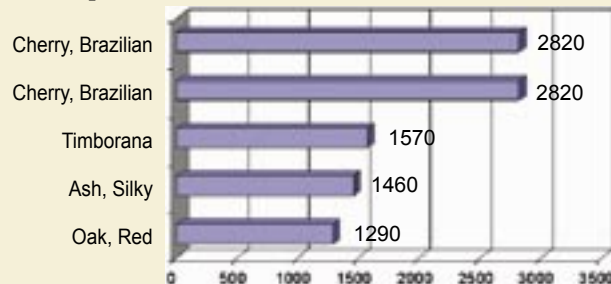

What is Engineered Wood Flooring?

Engineered wood flooring is designed to resist wood's natural tendency to change dimensionally over time. Comprised of multiple layers of wood, cross-banded for stability, this construction style is known as "engineered" wood flooring. Unlike solid wood flooring, engineered wood floors can be used in a greater range of installation settings and may be glued or stapled over a wide variety of subfloors.

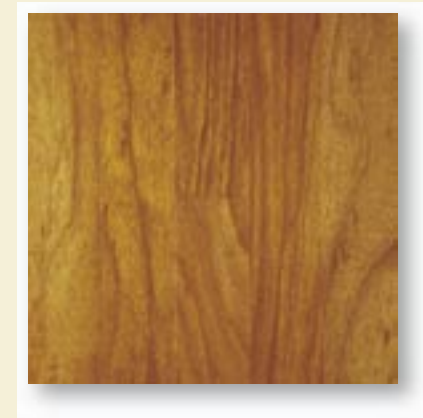


Comparative Hardness Chart
