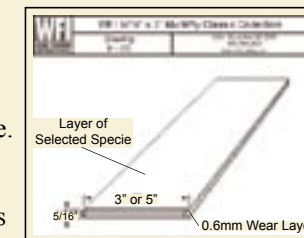

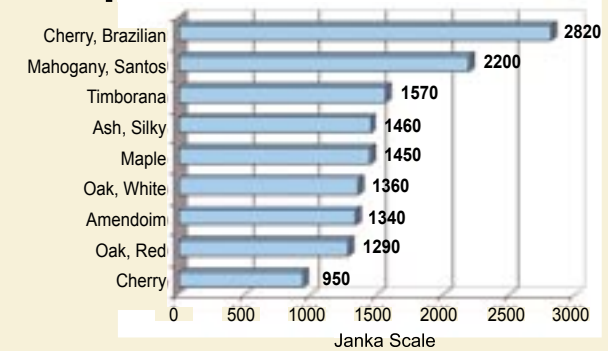
What is Engineered Wood Flooring?

Engineered wood flooring is designed to resist wood's natural tendency to change dimensionally over time. Comprised of multiple layers of wood, cross-banded for stability, this construction style is



known as "engineered" wood flooring. Unlike solid wood flooring, engineered wood floors can be used in a greater range of installation settings and may be glued or floated on a wide variety of subfloors.

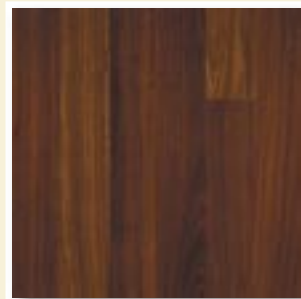
Comparative Hardness Chart

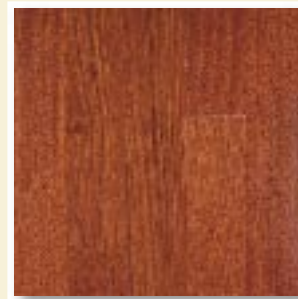
Santos Mahogany ▶

A darker Mahogany-looking type wood with extreme density and stability. One of the most popular exotic flooring choice and used wherever the distinguished look of mahogany will create a design statement.



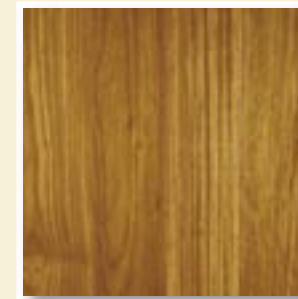
Brazilian Cherry ▶

The most popular imported flooring species. Known for its hardness and durability, it is a rich reddish-brown color which develops a darker patina over time. Very hard and dense.



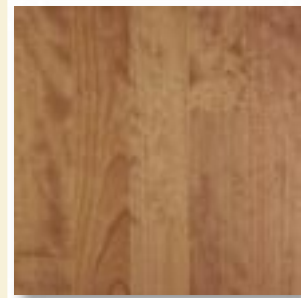
Timborana ▶

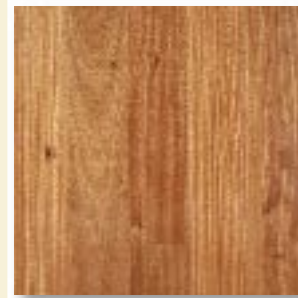
North American Cherry ▶

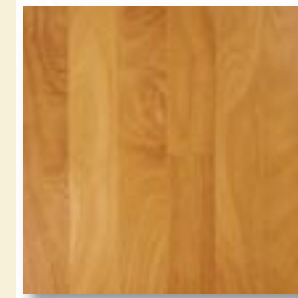
Amendoim ▶

The name says it all - a sleek, light-colored wood with fine graining that is quickly gaining in popularity for its warm cream to tan color tones and its positively silky luster and graining.



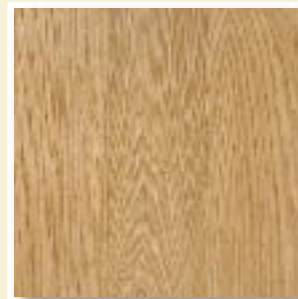
Red Oak ▶

America's most popular flooring choice. Our red oak is sourced from selected northern growing areas where you find tighter graining and the red oak exhibits more uniform pinkish tones.



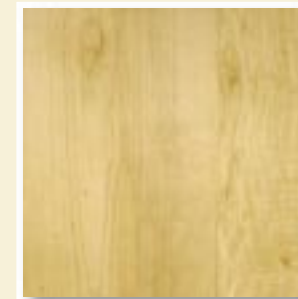
White Oak ▶
