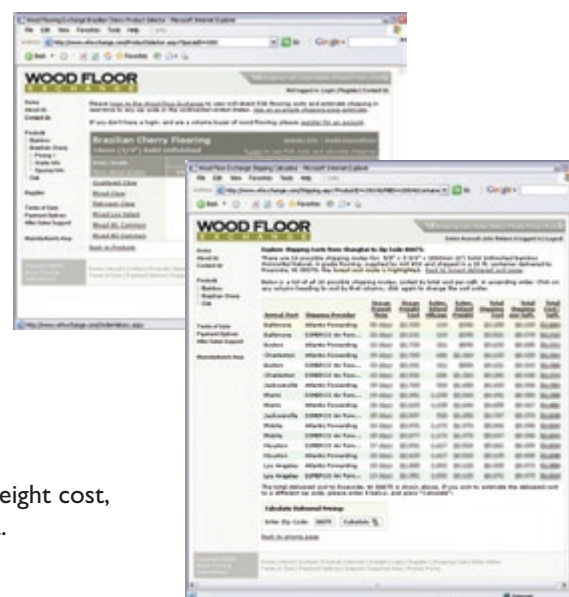

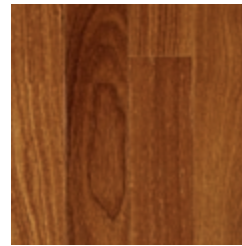


Brazilian Cherry

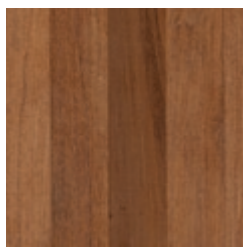


Brazilian Teak (Cumaru)

A dense, brownish-reddish wood with a unique coarse grain texture.

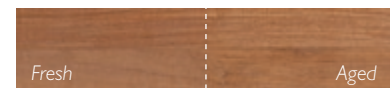

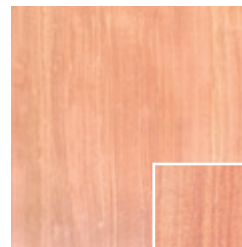


Brazilian Walnut (Ipe)

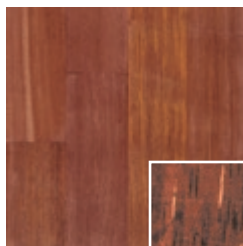
Chilean Cherry

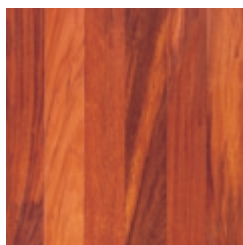


Patagonian Cherry (Tiete Rosewood)

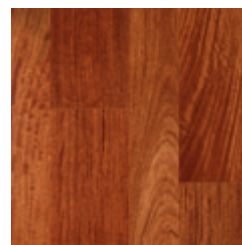


Patagonian Rosewood

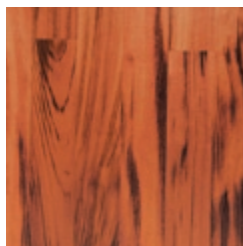


Santos Mahogany

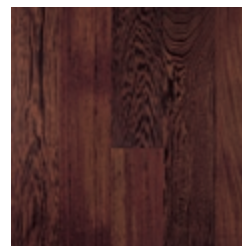


Tigerwood (Goncalo Alves)

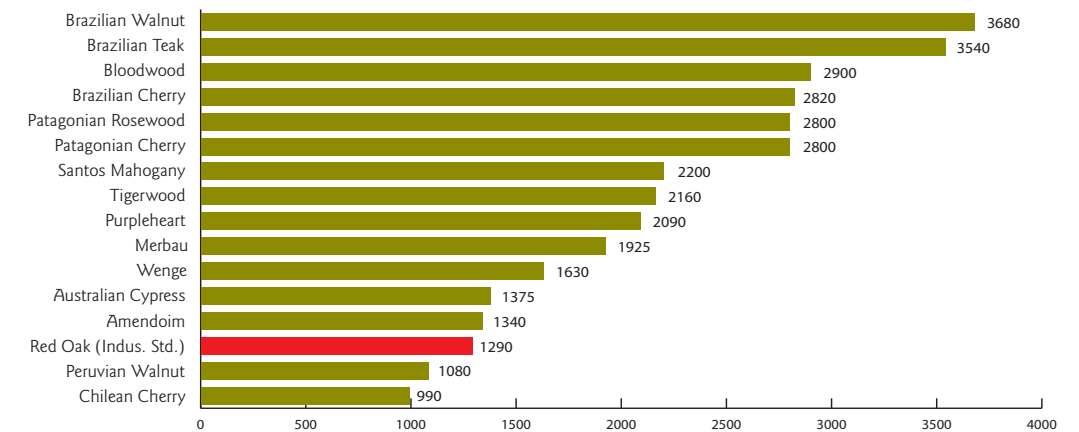
